Terms & Conditions:

- 1: Applicants must not have exhibited at any of the London Dollshouse Festivals in the last 5 years.
- 2: All entries must be handmade by the applicant. (any parts not made by the applicant, must be listed on the registration form).
- 3: Entries must be registered by LDF by **October 20th 2020** Confirmation of registration will be emailed by LDF on receipt of a completed registration form.
- 4: Entries must fall into the category of "FURNITURE-CARPENTRY". The main component of entries must be wood. We will accept any piece of furniture ie: chairs, sideboards, tables etc from any era. Furniture can include carving, inlay, marquetry, paint & gilded finishes. If you are unsure if your miniature will be accepted, please contact the LDF office.
- 5: The main skill demonstrated in your entry must fall into the category of "carpentry/wood turning", but other skills can also be used, ie: upholstery, weaving, metalwork etc
- 6: Entries must be submitted to LDF by post or delivery to the LDF Offices (PIMA Open Comp, LDF, The Studio, 70a Lawford Road, London N1 5BL), **between 1st – 13th November 2020**
- 7: All entries must be in 1:12 scale or smaller.
- 8: Applicants can only submit 1 entry as a solo artisan, but we will accept a second entry if in collaboration with another craftsman.
- 9: Judging will take place in prior to KDF Christmas Online Showcase (Nov 27th – Dec 4th 2020). Entries will remain with LDF for judging. Some entries will be featured on the LDF Website.
- 10: Applicants are allowed to work in collaboration with other craftsmen (non LDF exhibitors only), but any collaboration must be made clear on the Registration form.
- 11: Items entered must be new & unique. They must not have been available for sale in the past or be a previously commissioned item. Items can be sold after the competition has been judged.
- 12: Entries cannot be offered for sale or displayed at other shows or on social media/websites etc prior to the competition.
- 13: The Judges decision is final. Judges will be announced prior to the KDF Christmas Online Showcase.
- 14: Winners will be announced during the KDF Christmas Online Showcase from Nov 27th – Dec 4th 2020.
- 15: All entries will be returned after the KDF Online Showcase. Return postage must be paid for by the entrant (either we can send a paypal invoice for return postage charges, or correct UK postage can be included with the entry). Return postage label must be included with all entries.
