Terms & Conditions:

- 1: All applicants must be exhibiting at the LDF Online Christmas Show 2021, the Online Spring Showcase 2022, or the KDF Summer Show 2022.
- 2: All entries must be handmade by the applicant. (any parts not made by the applicant, must be listed on the registration form).
- 3: Entries must be registered with KDF by April 15th 2022. Confirmation of registration will be emailed by KDF on receipt of a completed registration form.
- 4: Entries must be delivered to the Kensington Town Hall on Thursday 12th May between 6pm – 8pm. If you are not able to deliver your entry to the Town Hall, you can deliver it to the LDF offices between May 2nd – 6th 2022. Postal address is '*LDF – PIMA Competition, The Studio, 70a Lawford Road, London N1 5BL*'. We will accept postal, or hand deliveries. Please let us know when to expect your entry. All applicants will be given a number for their entry. Only the item listed on the registration form will be accepted.
- 5: All entries must be in 1:12 scale or smaller.
- 6: Applicants can only submit 1 entry as a solo artisan, but we will accept a second entry if in collaboration with another LDF Exhibitor.
- 7: All entries must be available for purchase after the competition. (ie: not items pre ordered or commissioned by customers)
- 8: All entries will be photographed & displayed during the PIMA Showcase during the KDF London Showcase at Kensington Town Hall.
- 9: Applicants are allowed to work in collaboration with other LDF exhibitors, but this must be made clear on the Registration form.
- 10: Craftsmen not attending the LDF can make elements of an entry, as long as this is made clear on the registration form & the LDF Exhibitor does the main body of work.
- 11: Items entered must be new & unique. They must not have been available for sale in the past or be a previously commissioned item. Items can be sold after the competition has been judged.
- 12: **Entries cannot be offered for sale or displayed at other shows or on facebook/websites etc prior to the competition.**
- 13: The Judges decision is final. Judges will be announced prior to the Festival.
- 14: Winners will be announced at the KDF London Showcase. (details to be confirmed).
- 15: LDF is not responsible for any loss or damage to the miniature items in question. Please check with your insurance for cover.
- 16: Items can be sold at the KDF London Showcase. Items not sold must be collected at the end of the show or we will post them back if return postage is paid.
- 17: Prizes for the 2022 Competition are as follows: 1st Prize - £6000, 2nd Prize: £3000, 3rd Prize £1500.
- 18: We hope to run the People's choice Award. If this is possible, the People Choice Award prize will be £250.
